PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The pledge of allegiance was led by Chair Ayala.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: On motion by Trustee Castro and seconded by Trustee Olguin, the agenda was approved as delivered.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Council Member Adriana Marquez mentioned that due to confidentiality issues, the best way to share information with the parents is to send the flyers to the school administrators who will distribute the information through their digital platforms. Mayor Victor Legaspi said he does not advise the creation of a WhatsApp group because members of this board of trustees cannot be members of the same group outside of this board because that would violate the Brown Act.

LIBRARY MANAGER'S REPORT:

- Continued receiving class visits from Dool, Rockwood and Mains Elementary. Students visiting the library make a craft activity, participate in Story Time and receive a tote bag with library information and a free book.
- Kid's Book Club launched in January 2026. The book club meets twice a month and it's for children enrolled in grades 4th through 6th. The library currently hosts three book clubs for adults: Let's READ (English), Rincon Literario (Spanish) and Library Learners (for patrons enrolled in Adult Literacy Services).
- Library Manager conducted a presentation about library services at Jefferson Elementary School.
- February is Museum month. The library will be distributing passes for 50% off museum entrance. These passes are provided by the San Diego Museum Council. Anyone can go to the library and request a pass.

LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES COMMENTS:

Trustee Pacheco said even though she was unable to attend the Pajama Party Family Night, she saw pictures on social media and was glad to see such a good turnout. Trustee Castro would like to bring back to discussion the mascot idea. Trustee Castro said she would like to see a new library logo that is more appealing to the new generations. Chairperson Ayala proposed to have a contest for children to draw the new library mascot. The drawing that wins can be turned into a digital image and become the library mascot. Chairperson Ayala asked Ms. Legaspi if the mascot idea can be added as an agenda item in next month's meeting. Trustee Castro mentioned that she would like to see a flyer on social media advertising the library is open every Friday. Trustee Yepez mentioned she would like to see more activities being offered on Fridays. Ms. Legaspi said activities are limited on Fridays since it is the slowest day of the week. Trustee Pacheco volunteered to conduct an activity during a Friday at the library. Trustee Olguin reported attending the Pajama Party family night. She said she was happy to see new families attend the event. Trustee Olguin thinks the mascot idea is good but believes promoting the library through social media and word of mouth is more effective. Vice Chair Yepez asked if a WhatsApp group can be created to promote the library events.

CONSENT ITEMS:

1. Approval of Minutes for regular Meeting on January 5, 2026. On motion by Trustee Pacheco and seconded by Vice-Chair Yepez the minutes were approved as delivered.

DISCUSSION AND POTENTIAL ACTION ITEMS:

2. Teen Dating Violence Awareness – Camarena Library in partnership with Calexico Rotary will host a Teen Dating Violence Awareness panel. The panel will include representatives from different agencies, including the Imperial County District Attorney, Calexico Police Chief amongst others. The flyer has been sent to local junior high schools and Calexico High School.
3. 3D Printing Workshop at Carnegie Technology Center – 3D Workshop is back by popular demand. The workshop is taught by two volunteers. The maximum capacity is 8 students between the ages of 8-17. They must register to attend the workshop.
4. CARES Training & Support for Kids with Disabilities – CARES reached out to the library to host two trainings at the library. First session will be held on February 24th for teenagers ages 13 – 17 and the second session will be held on March 10th for young adults ages 18-24.
5. EmPOWERing Access Grant – Ms. Legaspi shared with the board that she applied for one Charlie cart and two light tables.
6. Parent Visits – Starting this month, we will begin with parents' visits. We will host two schools at a time. Parents will do a craft activity and will receive a small coloring book sponsored by Friends of the Library along with Library calendar.

7. Friends of the Library Report – Friends of the Library is conducting their annual fundraising event called \$26 in 2026. FOL recently purchased three titles for Rincon Literario Spanish Book Club. This expense was approved by FOL board during their last meeting. In addition, FOL sponsored the purchase of 400 books for school library visits. FOL continues to sponsor Cooking with Lizbeth and the meal provided at Family Literacy Night.

SUBJECT: **Library Board of Trustees Bylaws**

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Library Board of Trustees review the Bylaws adopted by the Calexico City Council.

Background:

On December 16, 2020, the Calexico City Council adopted Ordinance No.1211 amending the Calexico Municipal Code to establish the Library Board of Trustees to advise the Library and its City Council in accordance with Chapter 5 of Title 1 of the California Education Code commencing at Section 18900. The Library Board of Trustees at their April 3, 2023, meeting adopted a revised version of the bylaws. The bylaws were then brought to the City Council at the June 21, 2023, meeting for approval.

On January 15, 2025, the Calexico City Council adopted an ordinance amending several chapters of the municipal code. The two basic changes that impact on this board are the removal of the stipend to its members and the change of the frequency of its meetings.

LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES

BYLAWS

ESTABLISHED

A board to be known and designated as the Library Board of Trustees (“Board”) of the Camarena Memorial Library (“Library”) is created and established by City of Calexico Ordinance No. 1211 on December 16, 2020 to advise the Library in accordance with Chapter 5 of Title 1 of the California Education Code commencing at Section 18900, as it may be amended (“Municipal Libraries Act”).

ORGANIZATION

The Board shall consist of five members. Each city council member will appoint one Board member. If after a reasonable amount of time (not to exceed forty-five days) after an election is certified or vacancy otherwise exists), a city council member has failed to make an appointment, the appointment will be made by a majority vote of the city council, and the appointee shall not be removed from office except by majority vote of the city council.

Members shall hold office concurrently with the time in office of the city council member who appointed them.

All members shall be residents of Calexico or shall regularly work within the City during their term and are governed under Chapter 2.19 and Chapter 2.26 of the Calexico Municipal Code.

POWERS AND DUTIES

The Board shall have the following duties and powers:

1. Support the Camarena Memorial Library and other public libraries;
2. Aid in meeting the community’s educational, recreational, informational and cultural needs to encourage lifelong learning and the pursuit of knowledge;
3. Encourage use of traditional and innovative library services;
4. Promote and encourage public knowledge and use of library services and facilities;
5. Advise the City Council with regards to the Library and its services;

The Board shall have such specific duties and powers as the City Council from time to time invest in it.

The Board shall have no independent duties and no authority to take actions that bind the City of Calexico.

VACANCIES AND REMOVAL OF MEMBERS

1. A Board member may be removed at any time by the City Council Member who appointed such Board member to the Board for any reason and/or if the Board member is absent from three (3) regularly scheduled meetings in a calendar year.
2. Members will also be automatically removed for violating the Political Reform Act of 1974 as determined by the appropriate agency with authority to render such decisions or failing to comply with mandatory ethics training or conflict-of-interest filings required by the State of California or the City of Calexico.

COMPENSATION

Members of the Board shall serve without compensation.

OFFICERS

The officers of the Board shall consist of a Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson, to be elected by the Board, and such other officers as the Board may from time to time designate.

1. Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson will serve for a one-year term.
2. In the event of a vacancy in the Chairperson's position, the Vice-Chairperson shall succeed as Chairperson for the balance of the Chairperson's term and the Board shall elect a successor to fill the vacancy in the Vice-Chairperson's position for the remainder of the Vice-Chairperson's term.
3. Members willing to serve in either of these positions may submit their names for nomination. Members may also submit the names of other members for nomination.
4. The Vice-Chairperson shall perform the duties of the Chairperson when the Chairperson is absent.

MEETINGS

1. Regular meetings of the Board shall be held on the first Monday of each month. The regular meetings shall commence at 5:00 pm, at the Fernando "Nene" Torres Council Chambers in City Hall, located at 608 Heber Ave. Calexico, California. Whenever a regular meeting falls on a holiday observed by the City of Calexico, the meeting shall be held on another day or canceled at the direction of Library Administration.
2. The Board meetings shall be subject to the "Brown Act" (California Government Code Section 54952.3) for purposes of notices, agendas and holding meetings open to the public.

3. Quorum: For the purpose of conducting business, the Board of the whole shall have a quorum if a majority of members currently on the roster are present. If not majority after 15 minutes, the members may adjourn their meeting.
4. Agendas and meeting notes: All meetings of the Board of the whole shall be announced by a printed agenda, emailed, or distributed to all members, staff, and City Council members at least three working days prior to the meeting. Regular scheduled meetings must be posted 72 hours prior to meeting, and special meetings must be notified 24 hours prior to the meeting.
5. The Library Administrator will act as secretary but may be assisted by a library clerk to keep a proper record of the proceedings.

These bylaws shall be adopted and amended by the Board by the affirmative vote of a majority of its total membership and with the approval of the City Council.
