CALL TO ORDER: Meeting called to order at 5:02 pm by Chairperson Ayala.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The pledge of allegiance was led by Chairperson Ayala.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: On motion by Trustee Olguin and seconded by Trustee Pacheco, the agenda was approved as delivered.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: No Public Comments.

LIBRARY MANAGER'S REPORT:

- The carpet in the library's multipurpose room and Library Manager's office has been replaced.
- Thanks to the EmPOWERing Access Project grant the library received the Charlie Cart that will be used during cooking classes. We also received 4 tables from the Literacy Spaces grant. Three of these tables are at the library and the fourth table is at Carnegie Center.
- One of our part-time employees suggested the library hosts a FIFA World Cup Sticker Exchange event. This activity will take place all this week at 1:00 p.m. Today was the first day and we had about 15 people participating. We were happy to see patrons of all ages engage in this event.

LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES COMMENTS:

Trustee Pacheco mentioned she plans on attending the Men's Mental Health event taking place at the library. Trustee Olguin shared with the board that she continues to share the library's events her social media and the different chats she belongs to. Since last board meeting, Trustee Olguin attended the Vintage Club get together and the FIFA World Cup Sticker Exchange events at the library.

CONSENT ITEMS:

1. Approval of Minutes for Regular Meeting on May 4, 2026 - On motion by Trustee Pacheco and seconded by Chairperson Ayala the minutes were approved as delivered.

2. Nomination of Officers - Chairperson Ayala made a motion to nominate Trustee Olguin as Chairperson. Motion was seconded by Trustee Olguin. Motion passed unanimously. Chairperson Olguin made a motion to nominate Trustee Ayala as Vice Chair. Motion was seconded by Trustee Ayala. Motion passed unanimously.
3. Library's Friday Schedule Change – Ms. Legaspi shared with the board that a few years ago and due to the COVID pandemic, the library's schedule was modified. Now, that everything has gone back to normal and especially during the summer months when patrons are looking for activities indoors, we are extending the Friday schedule by one hour. The library will close at 6:00 p.m. on Fridays.
4. Men's Mental Health Program – Calexico Rotary Club is conducting Men's Mental Health event that will be hosted at the library. The keynote speaker will be Brendon Brown from Reps 4 Vets. They will also have nine resource tables.
5. Family Summer Reading Program Brochure - Ms. Legaspi shared with the board that she just got confirmation and will be adding the 3D Printing Lab to the FSRP brochure. The 3D Printing Lab conducted by Mr. Huerta will have two sessions in June and two sessions in July. Mr. Huerta has mentioned he will bring two 3D printers in addition to the two Carnegie Center owns. As of now, we have 120 people signed up for the Family Summer Reading Program.
6. Family Night Celebration of the 4th of July - The library will be hosting a Family Night to celebrate Independence Day. This year marks the 250 Anniversary of the Declaration of Independence and the library plans on celebrating with games, crafts, snacks and free books.
7. SERRA Cooperative Library System Meeting Dates – Camarena Library belongs to SERRA Cooperative Library System which is comprised of San Diego and Imperial County libraries. Camarena Library must belong to this group to receive funding from the State of California. The quarterly meetings are open to the public. In previous years, Camarena library used to host the February meeting. The February meeting has been held at El Centro since they opened their new library.
8. Canceling of July's Library Board of Trustees Meeting – Ms. Legaspi made a recommendation to the board to cancel the July meeting since it falls in the middle of the Family Summer Reading program. Ms. Legaspi mentioned this is the time when the library is the busiest. If anything was to come up that required, the board's approval, we could always call for a special meeting. Vice Chair Ayala motioned to approve the cancellation of July's regular meeting of the Library Board of Trustees. Motion was seconded by Chairperson Olguin.

9. Imperial Valley College Summer Classes at Carnegie Technology Center – Dr. Sydney Rice from Imperial reached out to Ms. Legaspi to partner in providing ESL classes to the community free of charge. Two six-week courses will be offered: Vocabulary Development and Reading to Write. Students interested must enroll through IVC. Ms. Legaspi mentioned she is working on an updated flyer which contains the QR code to register. These courses will be taught by Mr. Manuel Guzman.
10. Friends of the Library Report - No representative of Friends of the Library was present at this meeting. Ms. Legaspi reported that during the last meeting, Friends of the Library approved Ms. Legaspi the expenses for the Family Summer Reading Program. These expenses include prizes for children who turn in their reading logs, supplies for cooking and card making classes, and any other expense that the library might incur.

Mrs. Legaspi reviewed the items included under information including attendance report, monthly statistics report, New Booklist available online, and June calendars of activities for Camarena Memorial Library and Carnegie Technology Center.

SUBJECT: **Buzz Books Program**

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Library Board of Trustees receive information about the newly incorporated Buzz Books program.

Background:

Earlier this year, the library applied to the California State Library for the Zip Books program. The grant program provided funding to assist the library purchase books that were not in the collection. Books were purchased upon request from a patron. Unfortunately, at the beginning of July, we were informed that the State budget did not include funding for Zip books. Since the grant program had already paid for Amazon Prime subscription, we are taking advantage of it.

We will continue offering the same program model which is ordering books on demand. We are limiting the number of books to 2 per month per patron. A patron, who is a library card holder, simply requests the item they wish to read, the library purchases it from Amazon, and the book is shipped directly to the patron's home. After a regular check-out period (which consists of 28 days), the patron returns the item to the library and the library adds it to the collection.

Although we were able to use the same book program name, we wanted to change it to make a distinction. If funding through the state resumes later, we will go back to Zip books program. The current Buzz Books program will be using general fund monies to cover book expenses.

SUBJECT: **Integrated Library System – Sierra vs Polaris**

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Library Board of Trustees receives information about the possibility of upgrading its integrated library system from Sierra to Polaris.

Background:

The library has been an Innovative Interfaces client since 2000. Innovative Interfaces provides our current integrated library system (Sierra). This system allows us to keep track of all the materials that are available in the collection (including cataloging), patron records, statistics portal and Webpac (online catalog).

Our current system (Sierra) is a bit outdated and the Webpac does not meet the California website accessibility requirements that we must fulfill as part of the new regulation for Title II of the Americans with Disability Act (ADA) by April of 2028. This rule basically states that websites that are not accessible can create barriers to people with disabilities. In addition to this, the system is more geared to academic libraries.

Innovative will be providing a quote for Polaris. The new system will include Vega which is the updated and accessible online catalog for Polaris users. The new system also integrates digital content.
